LEGISLATIVE SCHOLARSHIPS

WHO MAY APPLY

Current high school seniors and full-time or part-time, degree-seeking undergraduate and graduate students. Students attending a private career school may also apply. Scholarship can be used at out-of-state institutions if the applicant is on active duty with the U.S Military and domiciled in the State. As well as if the student is disabled and studying at an institution outside the State that make special provision for disabled students that are not available to the applicant at an institution in the State.

SENATORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

ELIGIBILITY

REQUIREMENTS

- You and your parents (if you are a dependent student) must be Maryland residents.
- You must enroll at a two-year or four-year Maryland college or university, as a full-time or part-time, degree-seeking undergraduate or graduate student, or attend certain private career schools. Audited courses cannot be used to reach the minimum credit hours required for full-time or part-time status.
- You must demonstrate financial need.
- You must take the SAT 1 or the ACT unless you graduated from high school five or more years ago; have earned 24 college credit hours; or are attending a community college or a private career school.

DELEGATE SCHOLARSHIP

ELIGIBILITY

REQUIREMENTS

- Must contact Delegate for further instructions.
- If MHEC's OSFA makes the awards, a completed FAFSA is required.
- You and your parents (if you are a dependent student) must be Maryland residents.
- You must enroll at a two-year or four-year Maryland college or university as a full-time (12+ credits per semester) or part-time (6-11 credits per semester), degree-seeking undergraduate or graduate student, or attend certain private career schools.
