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VOLUME III Data Analysis

INTRODUCTION

Every three years, the Cultural Diversity Report includes detailed statistical data regarding student, faculty, and staff demographics at Maryland colleges and universities. Student data include information concerning age, gender, race/ethnicity, full-time/part-time enrollment, and educational outcomes. Faculty and staff data include gender, race/ethnicity, full-time/part-time status, and occupational categories. The brief analysis in this Volume will include highlights of current data, as well as observations on trends. These data are presented as Snapshot Data and Trend Data.

MHEC SUPPRESSION POLICY

The Maryland Higher Education Commission implemented a new Data Suppression Policy effective September 2019. This policy was implemented in accordance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA); contained in 20 U.S.C. § 1232g; 34 CFR Part 99. This policy states that MHEC will not publish data on a number of characteristics, including gender, race/ethnicity, and citizenship status, that might yield personally identifiable information concerning individual students, or if the number of students in a category might be insufficient to yield statistically significant information.

In order to protect student privacy, measures that have been utilized in reporting data in this report:

- 1. In instances where a subgroup total is smaller than 10, those subgroups have been suppressed. In order to prevent the calculation of suppressed cells, secondary suppression has been employed throughout the data tables; e.g., if the number of members of one racial group has been suppressed, the group with the next smallest number has also been suppressed to prevent calculating the value by subtracting from the total of all subgroups. This secondary suppression has also been employed at a segmental level; if one institution has subgroup values that have been suppressed, the subgroup totals for the institution with the next highest figures has also been also suppressed for these categories. In these instances, the secondary suppression figures may exceed 10.
- 2. Due to the small size of many racial and ethnic groups at the institutional level, racial and ethnic groups that would typically require suppression in reporting data have been aggregated in Snapshot Data. This means that racial and ethnic Snapshot Data are reported in the following categories:
 - a. White;
 - b. Black;
 - c. Asian;
 - d. Hispanic; and
 - e. Other this category includes all other racial/ethnic groups, including American Indian or Alaskan Native, Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander, Non-Resident Alien

and Foreign students, students reporting two or more races, and students for whom race is unknown.

HOW TO USE THE DATA

This volume consists of a compilation of Snapshot and Trend Data regarding selected demographic characteristics of the student, faculty, and staff populations at Maryland's public institutions, as well as student educational outcomes by gender and race/ethnicity. These two types of data have different, although related, utility:

- Snapshot Data provide a detailed analysis of data at the institutional and segmental levels at one point in time, reflecting the most current data collected. These data may be particularly useful when comparing institutions, or comparing institutional data to segment or statewide figures. However, it should also be noted that institutions are not necessarily directly comparable.
- Trend Data provide an analysis of summary data at the segmental level over time, reported in three-year increments to coincide with the Volume III reporting cycle. These data are useful in examining the evolution of diversity at Maryland colleges and universities. It is important to note, however, that as these data are at the segmental level and not at the institutional level, these figures may mask substantial variation across institutions. To keep the trend data reporting consistent over time, the racial/ethnic categories are restricted to Maryland's four largest racial and ethnic groups. Also noteworthy is that the 2010 changes to racial and ethnic category definitions means that figures before and after 2010 may not be directly comparable

KEY FINDINGS

- Community colleges and four-year public institutions have seen very different shifts in enrollment over the past decade and a half. Both saw large increases in enrollment around the time of the Great Recession, likely, in part, due to the economic conditions. However, while undergraduate enrollment at four-year public colleges and universities has continued to expand substantially, community college enrollment has declined. This may also be reflective of the economy; historically, as the economy strengthens, more potential students enter or stay in the workforce rather than attend community colleges.
- Statewide, the student body of Maryland's public colleges and universities is reflective of the racial/ethnic and gender diversity of the state's population. However, this has altered over time as members of groups historically underrepresented in higher education, particularly Hispanics, have enrolled at greater rates. At both the undergraduate and graduate levels, statewide, Maryland's public colleges and universities now serve a majority-minority student body.
- There is substantial variation across institutions in the level of racial/ethnic and gender diversity in the student population. This is particularly true at community colleges, where the racial and ethnic composition of the student body is largely driven by the demographics of the local service area. While institutions serving more urban areas tend

- to have a much larger share of their enrollments comprised by minorities, those locations serving rural communities have far less racial diversity.
- Graduation and transfer rates at Maryland community colleges have increased for each of the four largest racial/ethnic group and both genders.
- Retention and graduation rates at Maryland's four-year public colleges and universities have also increased for both genders and each of the four largest racial/ethnic groups.
- Despite the fact that rates of successful outcomes at both community colleges and fouryear public institutions have reached the highest rates on record for all subgroups, the uneven rates of increase mean that achievement gaps, particularly by race/ethnicity, persist.
- A strong majority of staff overall at both community colleges and four-year public institutions are female. The distribution of genders across occupational categories, however, is very uneven. Occupations such as construction, maintenance, military staff, and transportation are majority-male on Maryland campuses.
- Statewide, the racial/ethnic diversity of staff is fairly reflective of the demographics of the state. However, the racial/ethnic diversity of staff varies substantially by institution. This is especially notable at the community college level, likely reflecting the fact that community colleges draw particularly heavily from the local service area when recruiting for staff positions.
- There is greater diversity among faculty in institutions in urban areas than rural, again reflective of the demography of their surrounding areas. Additionally, those institutions with larger faculty populations tend to have more racially diverse faculty.
- Overall, the full-time instructional faculty populations differ substantially by segment in gender diversity, with community college faculty skewing heavily female and four-year institutions' faculty tipping majority male. However, gender and racial/ethnic diversity is substantially higher amongst junior faculty ranks than senior at four-year public institutions, which has contributed to an ongoing diversification of the overall faculty population.

CONCLUSION

Data show that Maryland public colleges and universities continue to make progress in increasing diversity throughout their institutions. However, there are a number of ways in which institutions must seek to increase diversity in terms of demographic representation in their student bodies and faculties and increase equity in student outcomes. Of particular concern is the ongoing equity gaps in student persistence and completion, the concentration of minority faculty members at particular institutions, and the disproportionality of specific genders in faculty ranks. Institutions should continue to seek out ways to address and remedy these important issues.
